

The Knightsbrook Health Club Child Admission Policy

The Child Protection Policy Of The Knightsbrook Health Club Is: That all children will be treated in co-operation with the recommended guidelines as outlined in the Code of Ethics for children's sport in Ireland.

Terms of reference as outlined by the White Flag are available to all staff members

- Under the Child Care Act 1991 a child is defined as "a person under the age of 18 years"
- Children have access to the pool and gym area from the hours of 6.30 am 7 pm Monday Sunday.
- Swim nappies must be worn by all babies and untrained toddlers in the pool area.
- Children over the age of 8 years are not permitted in to the changing rooms of the opposite gender. Family changing room is available for other children who may need assistance.
- Children under 12 years must be accompanied in the pool by an adult at all times.
- Parents of children attending kids camps/swimming lessons must leave the correct details with member of staff
- Parents must be present during the club swimming lesson at all times
- Children must be 13 years or over and must have completed a gym assessment with a qualified members of staff to be allowed to use the gym facilities.
- Children under 16 years of age are not permitted to use the free weight and the weight machines.
- These policies and procedures are liable to amendment. Any such amendments will be displayed in public areas of the leisure club as and when appropriate. It is the responsibility of the members to make themselves aware of any such changes or amendments. Admittance is subject to the decisions of Manager on Duty.
